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1 Introduction

It is foreseen that a separate waste collection system is introduced in the target cities at the end of the UrbanBiogas project. In order to support the urban waste companies a dedicated promotion campaign for citizens must be organised which highlights the trade-off of separate waste collection and sustainable biogas production. Campaigns include leaflets, stickers, promotional material and other activities.

In Abrantes and in the Médio Tejo and Pinhal Interior Sul region where Abrantes is positioned, several actions have been developed by the energy agency and waste management companies such as Valnor and resitejo. Both waste management companies are associated to the Urbanbiogas project by the signature of a partnership certificate and a protocol.

2 Overview of promotion of sustainable waste management activities in Abrantes

2.1 Promotion of sustainable waste management activities in Abrantes - Valnor

In Valnor several actions have been undertaken, namely:

- seminar related to the valorisation of waste oriented to schools;
- 2 seminars related to the importance of recycling were also implemented for the citizens in general;
- 1 seminar in cooperation with the municipality related to waste and its effect in the environment.


2.3 Promotion of sustainable waste management activities in Abrantes – MédioTejo21, on behalf of Abrantes municipality and IrRADIARE

From 16th to 24th of November (European week for waste reduction)

In the European week for waste reduction, MédioTejo21, on behalf of Abrantes municipality launched a questionnaire as a way for the population to commit towards a more sustainable waste management.

The questionnaire was available on Facebook and MédioTejo21's website. Considering that it was only available for one week, 50 people subscribed the commitment.

It was possible then to acknowledge that 100% of the citizens that answered the commitment are aware of how important the sustainable waste management is and at lease 80% by recycled products.



21st of November 2013

IrRADIARE and MédioTejo21 organized an event at the professional school of rural development in Abrantes. This event was held under European week for waste reduction, on the 21st of November.

The idea of this event was to raise awareness for the importance of sustainable waste management.

The event had the participation of Resitejo, MédioTejo21, on behalf of Abrantes Municipality and IrRADIARE.

At the event several ecopoints were distributed to the students.
